

## The King's Coronation 2023 Photo Competition – Salehurst & Robertsbridge Parish Council

Wouldn't it be great for future residents of Salehurst & Robertsbridge to be able to look back at photos of the local Coronation Celebrations? Serious, funny, human, animal, mineral or vegetable.... The aim of this competition is to help to build a fantastic collection of Coronation photos just like we did for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in 2022.

### Competition Rules

1. The competition is open to all residents who live in the parish of Salehurst & Robertsbridge.
2. Each entry must be a colour or black and white photograph of something or someone at one of the Coronation events held in Salehurst & Robertsbridge Parish over the weekend of 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> May 2023
3. There will be 3 age categories The winner in each age group will receive a prize as follows:  
**Category 1 Children (11 and younger on the day the competition closes)**  
*Prize: Meet the Alpacas Experience at Fisherwood Farm, Robertsbridge*  
**Category 2 Under 18s (12-17 on the day the competition closes)**  
*Prize: Two pizzas from Martin Pizza (pizza van which regularly visits Robertsbridge)*  
**Category 3 Adults (18 and over on the day the competition closes)**  
*Prize: Two places at Mountfield Winery vineyard tour on 27<sup>th</sup> May or 17 June 2023 11am-1pm*
4. Each entrant can enter one photograph they have personally taken (The competition is free to enter.)
5. Please email your entry to [clerk@salehurst-pc.org.uk](mailto:clerk@salehurst-pc.org.uk) together with the subject, date, event and location of the photograph. If you are under 18 please also include your age.
6. The deadline for entries is midnight on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
7. When submitting the photograph, you are giving permission for it to be included in the Parish archive and for it to be published on the Parish website and/or on Facebook pages. Please note that not all photographs will be selected. If selected for inclusion on our website we will need to edit to 900 by 675 pixels.
8. Permission must be sought for taking photographs which identify adults or children. Parents or carers must give permission for any photographs taken of children. If your photograph is selected to be included in the Parish archive or to be published online this parental permission must be given in writing, which can be supplied at the point of selection.
9. Entries will be judged by a panel.
10. Winners will be announced by 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
